



Euchre League Frequently Asked Questions

When does the season begin?

Sedgwick's Euchre League takes place throughout the year, with season's beginning in January (Winter League), April (Spring League), July (Summer League), and September (Fall). Be sure to visit sedgwickschicago.com/euchre to for the most up-to-date information on when the next season will begin.

Do you need a partner to play?

Yes, players sign up as teams for the Sedgwick's Euchre League. If you don't have a partner, feel free to email sedgwickseuchre@gmail.com and we can try to pair you up with anyone else looking for a partner.

How many people are on a team?

Teams consist of two people, who would play together each week against an opposing team.

How long does the league last?

The Winter, Spring, and Fall Leagues have a nine-week regular season, followed by a three-week, single elimination playoff tournament. The Summer League has a five-week regular season, followed by a three-week, single-elimination playoff tournament.

How much is the cost per team?

The cost per team for the Winter, Spring, and Fall Leagues is \$40. The cost per team for the Summer League is \$20, as it is a shorter league.

How do we pay for the league?

You can pay via the PayPal link at the bottom of the [Euchre page](#) on the [Sedgwick's Website](#) or you can pay in cash the first week of the league.

What night do we play?

Teams can play on either Monday or Tuesday nights, depending on which night is selected upon sign up, and availability on either night. Teams will play on only one night during the season. If there is not availability on a selected night, you will be contacted directly by Sedgwick's.

What time do we play?

All games begin at 7:00 pm.

What are the rules of play for the euchre league?

The rules of play are standard euchre rules and they will be provided by Sedgwick's prior to the start of the season.

How many games do we play each week?

Each week will consist of a best-of-five match. Each game in that match will be played to 10 points.

Who do we play each week?

Sedgwick's will schedule you to play another participating team each week.

Can we miss a week?

Teams are generally allotted one bye week per season. More information will be provided on how to take a bye prior to the season beginning.

Can substitute players play on our team?

Teams are able to have one substitute player any week with no restrictions. Sedgwick's asks that one member of the original team is available to play every week.

What happens if we don't show up?

If you do not show up and do not tell Sedgwick's prior to 5:00 pm on the day of play that you are not able to play a particular week, your team will receive a 0-3 loss.

What happens if our opponents don't show up?

If your opponents do not show up, you will first be paired with another team that does not have an opponent. If that is not possible, your team will receive a 3-0 win.

What are the prizes?

Prizes vary from season to season, and will be announced when presented.

How do we find out standings?

The standings will be emailed out to the league teams each week after the games have been played.

Do we need to bring a deck of cards?

No. Cards will be provided by Sedgwick's.

What is a Joker Prize?

One table each week will have a Joker in their deck of cards. That table will draw for a prize for the night, which can range from a free round of drinks to a percentage off your tab for the evening.
